

Social inclusion key to scientific pursuit, says President

Murmu opens HAL's Cryogenic Engine Manufacturing Facility

Indigenisation and social inclusion are critical in driving science to improve the lives of the masses, President Droupadi Murmu said on Tuesday.
She was speaking after inaugurating the Hindustan Aeronautics Limited's Integrated Cryogenic Engine Manufacturing Facility here.
Referring to the path of

technological development and social inclusion pursued by late president Dr A P J Abdul Kalam, she said science could bring a phenomenal revolution and touch the lives of the masses. "Dr Kalam too touched the lives of masses by designing the Kalam-Raju stent," she said.
The indigenous coronary stent had helped thousands of patients while being affordable in comparison with the imported stents. "...the spirit of

indigenisation, which was pursued by Dr Kalam, has a great, positive impact on our society. The hard work and research pursued by our scientists can save the lives of many people. I urge the scientist community of India to pursue the path of social responsibility," the President said.
She called for a reimagining of India to help it emerge as a stronger nation when it enters its 100th year of independence in 2047. The President inaugurated the facility in the presence of Governor Thaaar Chand Gehlot and Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai.
Bommai called Bengaluru 'Space City' and said Karnataka has contributed to most of India's space and de-

ference-related manufacturing activity. About 65 per cent of the country's aerospace parts exports are from Bengaluru and 60 per cent of defence equipment is manufactured in the city, he said.
Referring to the state's aerospace, defence and R&D policies, the chief minister said the state government is keen on collaborations that could steer new research initiatives.
NIV zonal campus
Murmu virtually laid the foundation stone for the construction of the zonal campus of the Pune-headquartered National Institute of Virology (NIV).
Currently, Bengaluru is one of the three NIV field stations in the country. Under the PM

Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission, the Bengaluru station will be upgraded from a BSL-2 lab to a BSL-3 lab. The institute's capacity will be increased as well.
On the occasion, she lauded the expansion of NIV through its zonal campuses.
Union Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare Dr Bharati Pawar, said, "The South zone ICMR-NIV lab in Bengaluru is a step to further strengthen our health defence system. It will be equipped with state-of-the-art infrastructure and expertise in handling infectious agents. This will be crucial in continuous monitoring of infectious diseases in South India, and will bolster surveillance."

India's silicon city got a pat on its back from none other than President Droupadi Murmu on Tuesday.
Murmu said she likes Bengaluru 'very much' and expressed confidence that Karnataka would play a major role in making India a \$5 trillion economy.
She was speaking at a civic reception organised for her by the state government at the banquet hall of Vidhana Soudha.
"When I came here for the first time during the presidential election campaign, I told the chief minister that I like Bengaluru and entire Karnataka very much," Murmu said.
"Because, this is a city whose people have a large

heart towards not just people of the country, but also the world. The city is so peace-loving," she said. Karnataka, Murmu said, has played a leading role in modern industrial development.
"It is a leading state in many fields like bio-technology, heavy engineering, aviation, research and development, space science and technology. Karnataka is making an invaluable contribution as a leading education and research hub of our country," she said.
"Visionary politicians, business leaders and entrepreneurs of Karnataka have developed a very good eco-system for industrial development, es-

pecially for start-ups," she said.
In his speech, CM Bommai said the civic reception in Murmu's honour was a first-of-its-kind event.
"A civic reception for the first citizen of India had not happened before," he said.
"Murmu had come to Bengaluru before becoming President. She said she'd like to visit again after becoming President. I told that she'd have ample opportunities to visit," he said. Governor Thaaar Chand Gehlot, acting Chief Justice of Karnataka High Court Justice Alok Aradhe, Speaker Vishweshwar Hegde Kageri and others were present on the occasion.

Every university should be world class: Murmu

President Droupadi Murmu has urged higher education institutions in the country to identify themselves globally.
Speaking at the inauguration of St Joseph's University here on Tuesday, Murmu said though there are more than a number of higher education institutions in the country, not all are world-class.

Narayan, Bangalore Archbishop Peter Machado and others were present.
"Very few of them have been identified at the global level. Every university should make efforts to get global recognition," she said. Murmu mentioned that lack of global exposure at our universities was forcing students to opt for foreign universities.
"Many of our students look towards the West for research and higher learning. Every educational institution in our country should be world-class and play the role of change agents," she added.
Hailing the National Education Policy (NEP), Murmu called it an effort to make academics "align with changing needs".
Murmu is the third President to visit St Joseph's. In 1957, then president Rajendra Prasad visited the institute, followed by Neelam Sanjiva Reddy in 1982. St Joseph's College (autonomous) received university status in April 2021, under the Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA). Started in 1882, St Joseph's is managed by the Bangalore Jesuit Educational Society.
